

Scholarship Competition for Teachers of Italian

The Italian Didactic Centre of SA Inc. announces a competition for all South Australian teachers of Italian in celebration of the Ninth Edition of Italian Language Week Worldwide (October 2009).

Teachers are required to develop a complete **"Innovative Program for the Teaching of the Italian Language in South Australia"**. The program must be in accordance with the South Australian Curriculum Standards and Accountability Framework requirements.

Teachers must be registered with the Teachers Registration Board of South Australia and be currently employed in a part-time or full-time position in a South Australian primary or secondary school.

The Program must be based on this year's theme, **"Gli Italiani nel Mondo dell'Arte, della Scienza e della Tecnologia"**.

All entries must be in Italian.

One winner will be selected by a judging panel and awarded with a scholarship for a standard two-week Italian Language and Culture Course at Accademia Lingua Italiana Assisi.

The prize includes:

- Return economy airfares to Italy and transfers to and from Assisi by Train or Bus
- Course fees

Entries to be sent to the Italian Didactic Centre of SA Inc, 10 Newton Road CAMPBELLTOWN SA 5074 by **17th September 2009** (*no extension will be given*).

Important: Please ensure that your name does not appear on any part of the entry but on the cover sheet provided.

On return to Australia, the winners must provide a written evaluation on their experience in Italy and attend an informal meeting at the Italian Didactic Centre of SA Inc.

Any teacher wishing to participate in this competition must complete the attached Registration Form and send it to the Italian Didactic Centre by **Monday 15th June 2009**.

Please ensure that you are able to travel to Italy between 1st December 2009 and 31st January 2010 before entering this competition.

The winner will be awarded the Scholarship at an official ceremony in October 2009.

Terms & Conditions

1. Information on how to enter and prize details form part of these Terms & Conditions of Entry.
2. The Promoter is the Italian Didactic Centre of SA Inc (Centro Didattico), Australian Business Number: 84 282 830 629.

4. Entry is limited to South Australian residents only. No group entries allowed.
5. Entry is for current Registered Teachers with the Teachers Registration Board of South Australia and who have not won this scholarship previously. This is a competition of skill and chance plays no part in determining the winners.
6. The Promoter reserves the right at any time to verify the validity of entries and Entrants (including an Entrant's identity, and place of residence) and to disqualify an Entrant who submits an entry that is not in accordance with these Terms and Conditions.
7. All participants are requested to send their entries to the Promoter by mail. They are also required not to write their names on their entries or place any other mark that may lead to their identification. **Entries must be received by the Promoter by 17/09/2009.** Entries not received by this date or not completed in accordance with these Conditions will not be eligible to win. No responsibility is accepted for late, lost or misdirected entries. Valid entries will be judged and the entry judged to be most creative will be selected as the winner. Judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into. All care will be taken but no responsibility will be accepted for any misplaced work.
8. The winner will be notified by mail and prize will be awarded in October 2009. The winner will be awarded with a Scholarship for a standard two-week Italian Language and Culture Course at Accademia Lingua Italiana Assisi. The prize includes; Return economy airfares to Italy and transfers to/from Assisi by Train or Bus. **All spending money, accommodation, meals, transfers, insurance and other ancillary costs are the liability of the winner.** The prize is not transferable, upgradeable or exchangeable and cannot be taken as cash. **Prize is valid for travel from 1st December 2009 to 31st January 2010** (Course dates to be advised).
9. The Promoter will not be liable for any loss or damage which is suffered (including but not limited to indirect or consequential loss) or for personal injury which is sustained as a result of taking any of the prizes, except for any liability which cannot be excluded by law.
10. On return to Australia, the winner must provide the Promoter with a **written evaluation** on their experience in Italy and attend an **informal meeting** at the Italian Didactic Centre of SA Inc.
