**Scholarship for TEACHERS OF ITALIAN in celebration of the
Eighth Edition of Italian Language Week Worldwide
(20-26 October 2008)**

The Italian Didactic Centre of SA Inc. announces a competition for all South Australian teachers of Italian.

Entry Requirements:

Teachers are required to develop a complete **“Innovative Program for the Teaching of the Italian Language in South Australia”**. The program must be in accordance with the South Australian Curriculum Standards and Accountability Framework requirements.

Teachers must be registered with the Teachers Registration Board of South Australia and be currently employed in a South Australian primary or secondary school.

The Program must be based on this year’s theme, **“Italians in the Square”**.

Following are some examples of topics that may be chosen:

- The square as a meeting place (i.e. the importance of the square in the village)
- An event that takes place in a square (i.e. Palio di Siena etc.)
- Historical battles/revolts that happened in a square
- Shows, concerts, theatre plays, feste, parades, markets, sagre gastronomiche
- Paintings, films, songs (i.e. Piazza grande di Lucio Dalla)
- The square as inspiration to poets, artists and songwriters
- Elections rallies, students’ demonstrations etc.

All entries must be in Italian.

Prize

One winner will be selected by a judging panel and awarded with a scholarship for an Italian Language and Culture Course in Italy.

The prize includes:

- Return economy airfares to Italy
- Course fees at an educational institution in Italy (Details to be advised)
- \$500.00 spending money
